

## PESA FEDERAL TREASURER REPORT

## Year Ended 31 December 2023

## 1. Year End 2023 Financial Report

The 2023 financial report was audited by StewartBrown.

PESA is reporting a net profit for 2023 of \$68,808 compared with a net loss of -\$6,569 in the previous year, and a net loss of -\$61,676 in 2021.

The key changes in 2023 that resulted in this difference are:

- i. Income in the form of term deposit interest received grew by \$25,820 from 2022 levels as a result of rising interest rates during 2023.
- ii. A very popular short course run by the South Australian branch, along with increased sponsorship for branch technical talk programmes in WA resulting in a \$19,487 increase in function revenue.
- iii. Conference income from a well-managed AEGC in Brisbane of \$71,407.18.

The operating revenue for the Society for the year of 2023 was \$555,910, and at the year-end 2023, total assets were \$1,359,811, a return to 2020 levels, but not back to the highs of \$2,102,127 of 2010.

Since 2012, PESA revenue has generally been falling, but from 2014, after a few years lag, so have our expenses, leaving the Society in a stable position. The audit report will be available on the website sent out with the AGM material.

## 2. Auditor Appointment

At the 2020 AGM the members voted to appoint StewartBrown as the Society's auditor. They proved to be competent and efficient in their year-end 2021 audit, and the same has been true for their year-end 2022, and 2023 audits. The Board is happy with their work and recommends retaining them for the Society's year end 2024 audit.
