

PESA FEDERAL CHAIRMAN REPORT

Year Ended 31 December 2024

In the current rapidly changing national energy landscape PESA – Energy Geoscience remains focussed on promoting professional and technical excellence in all aspects of energy geoscience. Over the last few years, the society's scope has broadened from petroleum exploration to include 'geo-energy' – geoscience aspects of Carbon Capture and Storage (CCS), gas storage, natural hydrogen and geothermal energy.

The PESA Federal Board remains strongly focussed on creating more value for all PESA members by ensuring that we continue to deliver cost-effective, relevant and innovative services and products in this time of these rapid and dramatic global-national scale changes impacting Australia's energy resource sector.
